OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS - 030352, 030353 - Engine Stands

Important: read these instructions and all warnings prior to using this equipment. Understand all operating procedures, safety warnings and maintenance requirements. Failure to do so could cause an accident resulting in serious or fatal injury and/or personal property damage.

\land Warning

The use of shop equipment is subject to certain hazards that cannot be prevented by mechanical means, but only by exercise of intelligence, care, and common sense. Inspection

Visual inspection shall be made before each use of this equipment, checking for abnormal conditions, such as cracked welds, leaks, damaged, loose or missing parts. This equipment shall be removed immediately from service if it is believed to have been subjected to an abnormal or shock load, the equipment shall be inspected by a qualified repair facility. Owners and / or operators should be aware that repair of this equipment may require specialized knowledge and facilities. It is recommended that this equipment be inspected annually by a qualified repair facility. Defective parts, decals, safety labels or signs should be replaced with Strongarm specified parts.

- When using various shop equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed.
- Keep work area clean and free from debris.

- Study, understand, and follow all instructions before operating this device.

- Do not work underneath the engine when being lifted or suspended.
- Lock mounting plate rotating mechanism before applying a load.
- Ensure load is centered and secured to mounting attachments.
- Off-center loads may make the load and handle rotate in either direction when the rotational locking device is released.
- Release rotational locking device slowly and carefully.
- Only attachments and/or adapters supplied by the manufacturer shall be used.
- No alterations shall be made to this product.
- Failure to heed these instructions may result in personal injury and/or property damage.

Assembling

Minor assembly of this unit is needed. Use the parts drawing as your guide to assembly. Lay all parts and assemblies out in front of you before beginning.

Mounting

- 1. Remove the engine from the vehicle using an appropriately rated Engine Crane or lifting device.
- 2. Remove the bell housing from the engine.
- 3. Remove or secure any loose engine components.
- 4. Remove the Mounting head assembly from the Engine Stand and attach to the engine referring to the vehicle or engine manufacturers' guidelines using Grade 5 bolts, ensuring the engine centre of gravity aligns properly with the rotational axis of the mounting head. Tighten bolts.
- 5. With the engine removed from the vehicle and the Engine Stand Mounting head centered and secured to the engine, align the mounting head assembly with the Engine Stand receiver tube and secure in place using the Locking Pin / Bolt.

WARNING – If the engine is not centered properly, the load and handle may rotate in either direction when the locking pin / bolt is removed.

- 6. Before disconnecting the engine from the Engine Crane or Lifting device, ensure the engine is secured firmly to the Engine Stand, and that the Rotational locking pin/bolt is tight and is stable.
- 7. Insert Handle through Mounting head assembly tube and secure.

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Dismounting

- 1. Attach an appropriately rated Engine Crane or Lifting device, to the engine.
- 2. Slowly raise the engine to relieve the weight from the Engine Stand.
- WARNING If the engine is not centered properly, the load and handle may rotate in either direction when the locking pin / bolt is removed.
- 3. Remove the handle from the Mounting head
- 4. Slowly and carefully remove the Rotational Locking Pin / Bolt.
- 5. With the load secured to the Engine Crane or Lifting device, slowly separate the Mounting head assembly and Engine from the Engine Stand
- 6. Remove the Mounting head assembly from the engine.

Maintenance

Store Engine Stand in a clean and dry environment. Using a general purpose grease, lubricate wheels, casters, and mounting head assembly tube.
